protected leathers**

— INSTRUCTIONS —



Always test these products in an inconspicuous area of your furniture to ensure compatibility and mitigate the risk of damage.

The products in this kit have been specifically formulated to ensure that your leather furniture can be cared for in the correct way without the risk of damage to the finish.

Coated and Protected Leathers have been produced with a durable pigmented finish on them but care is still very important.

The first rule of cleaning, as with all leather finishes, is to avoid excessive rubbing, let the product contained in the sachet do the work and massage it into the soiled or stained area gently.

Leather Soft Cleaner

Soft cleaner is a 'regular use' mild cleaner. Frequency of use is determined by lifestyle but we would recommend that you clean the main contact areas at least once a month.

- Open the sachet and remove the cloth
- Wipe across the areas to be cleaned in a circular motion applying a light even pressure
- Let the surface dry thoroughly before resuming use
- Repeat if required or on heavier soiling

Leather Protection Cream

Leather Protection Cream when applied onto clean leather will create a protective barrier on your leather furniture ensuring that it will be harder to stain or soil and cleaning will be easier. (similarly on the Natural).

- Open the sachet and remove the cloth
- Wipe across the areas to be protected in a circular 'massaging' motion applying a light even pressure ensuring even distribution of the cream
- Let the surface dry thoroughly before resuming use
- We recommend that you apply Leather Protection Cream after every other clean

Stubborn Stain and Fresh Ink Cleaner

Stubborn Stain and Fresh Ink Cleaner is an 'occasional use' strong cleaner. It is intended for less frequent use than the Soft Cleaner, to be used to target stains that are proving more difficult to remove than others.

- Open the sachet and remove the cloth
- Wipe across the areas to be cleaned in a circular motion applying a light even pressure
- Let the surface dry thoroughly before resuming use
- Repeat if required or on heavier soiling
