


Active Clean

This product is designed to be used for the removal of stains originating from the spillage of everyday drinks such as tea, coffee, wine and is also effective against bodily fluids such as urine and blood. As with all stain removers let the product do the work and avoid rubbing.

- Apply the stain remover directly onto the stain and leave to dwell for approximately 2 minutes
- Roll the microfibre cloth gently but firmly across the affected area, starting at the outer edge of the stain. Apply even pressure working from the outside of the stain inwards. Allow the cloth to 'pickup' until the stain is no longer visible
- 'Dab' the solid area several times with a clean damp cloth or absorbent tissue to remove any residual dampness and stain remover
- Repeat the process if necessary or switch to an alternative product if stain removal was not successful

Fabric Care Kit

— INSTRUCTIONS —



Always test these products in an inconspicuous area of your furniture to ensure compatibility and mitigate the risk of damage.

This Premium Care Kit is supplied to you by Staingard in association with DFS. The contents of this kit have been specially formulated to ensure that you can maintain the appearance of your furniture by taking care of everyday soiling and staining.

Before using this kit please follow these simple guidelines:

- Remove any solid matter with a blunt knife or spoon
- Soak up as much liquid as possible using clean dry towels or kitchen tissue
- Avoid rubbing at all costs as this will damage the fabric
- Always 'dab' the stain with a clean colour-fast towel or gently 'roll' a microfibre cloth over the stain
- A very effective way to use the microfibre cloth provided is to dampen the cloth with fresh clean water and create a 'sausage shape' then 'roll' the cloth over the affected area. Rinse the cloth under clean running water before repeating where necessary. This will ensure that no pickup on the cloth from the stain is transferred onto your fabric
- Always pre-test the product in an inconspicuous area

Handy Hint:

Water marks around a stained area can be avoided by lightly dampening the whole panel of fabric to be cleaned with clean de-ionised water or by using clean cold water from a recently boiled kettle. Clean your microfibre cloth in similar water too.

Stain Away

This product is designed to be used for the removal of most fresh stains and general soiling. As with all stain removers let the product do the work and avoid rubbing.

- Apply the stain remover directly onto the stain and leave to dwell for approximately 2 minutes
- Roll the microfibre cloth gently but firmly across the affected area, starting at the outer edge of the stain. Apply even pressure working from the outside of the stain inwards. Allow the cloth to 'pickup' until the stain is no longer visible
- 'Dab' the solid area several times with a clean damp cloth or absorbent tissue to remove any residual dampness and stain remover
- Repeat the process if necessary or switch to an alternative product if stain removal was not successful

Resistant Stain Cleaner

This product is designed to be used for the removal of stains of unknown origin or that may have been on the fabric for some time. As with all stain removers let the product do the work and avoid rubbing.

- Apply the stain remover directly onto the stain and leave to dwell for approximately 5 minutes
- Roll the microfibre cloth gently but firmly across the affected area, starting at the outer edge of the stain. Apply even pressure working from the outside of the stain inwards. Allow the cloth to 'pickup' until the stain is no longer visible
- 'Dab' the solid area several times with a clean damp cloth or absorbent tissue to remove any residual dampness and stain remover
